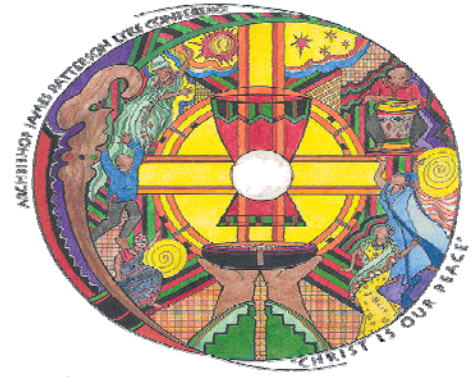


Archbishop James P. Lyke Conference **“The Way, The Truth and The Life”**
